MUSICAL THURSDAY's!! - Write On Songwriting Experience



Okay.. so musical Thursday's doesn't quite have the same ring to it as musical Monday's, but after a very successful 2018 (18 amazing songs!) and due to a number of requests we have changed the class to Thursday afternoon at the school library from 3:45-4:45 on Thursdays.

Over the course of 2019 we will embark on a musical journey touching on many of the major genres of music. In each one hour class we will compile a song based on the children's lyrical input. Throughout these sessions we will aim to introduce them to genres such as folk, rock, reggae, country, rap, pop, blues, dance, funk and tribal grooves, touching on lyrical messages, rhythm, syncopation, percussion, rhymes, hook, choral singing, chanting, backing, lead vocals and harmony.

Each class will be independent of the others, so if a child misses one class, there is no need to be concerned as to continuity. Once each session has been completed, I will take the recordings, and compile them into a listenable song for them to keep, share and distribute as they feel in MP3 format.

The classes will be priced at \$25 per session, or all 9 classes can be paid prior to term commencement for \$200. Early bird payments close Tuesday 5 February 2019.
