ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Victorian Primary School Nursing Program

Cathy Gray a visiting primary school nurse from the Department of Education and Training will be attending the school to conduct the Foundation grade health assessments and to see other children as requested by parents or teachers (with parents' consent).

The purpose of the visit is to provide all Victorian children with the opportunity to have a health assessment; to link children, families and school communities to services available in the community; and to provide information and advice that promotes health and wellbeing.

Parents of students (other than Foundation students) that wish their child to be seen by the school nurse need to complete a Referral form that is available from the office. This completed Referral form needs to be returned to the school office.

CSEF is provided to eligible families to assist with the cost of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

Parents and carers may claim the CSEF of \$125 per year, if you hold an eligible concession card. To apply please contact the office or download a CSEF application form from www.education.vic.gov.au/csef and provide us with a copy of a current concession card. Closing date for application is Friday 5th April 2019. For more information visit the above web site.

You will only need to submit an application form in 2019 if any of the following changes have occurred:

- new student enrolments: your child has started or changed schools in 2019 or you did not apply at the same school in 2018 or
- changed family circumstances: such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing at the school in 2019.

School Swimming Carnival Lost Property


A number of items including socks, goggles and towels were left behind at our school swimming carnival yesterday. Please come and collect any lost items from the school office lost property.

MUSICAL THURSDAY's!! - Write On Songwriting Experience

Okay.. so musical Thursday's doesn't quite have the same ring to it as musical Monday's, but successful 2018 (18 amazing songs!) and due to a number of requests we have changed the class to Thursday afternoon at the school library from 3:45-4:45 on Thursdays.

Over the course of 2019 we will embark on a musical journey touching on many of the major genres of music. In each one hour class we will compile a song based on the children's lyrical input. Throughout these sessions we will aim to introduce them to genres such as folk, rock, reggae, country, rap, pop, blues, dance, funk and tribal grooves, touching on lyrical messages, rhythm, syncopation, percussion, rhymes, hook, choral singing, chanting, backing, lead vocals and harmony.

Each class will be independent of the others, so if a child misses one class, there is no need to be concerned as to continuity. Once each session has been completed, I will take the recordings, and compile them into a listenable song for them to keep, share and distribute as they feel in MP3 format.

The classes will be priced at \$25 per session, or all 9 classes can be paid prior to term commencement for \$200. Early bird payments close Tuesday 5 February 2019.
