As a reminder, please encourage children to hold onto their basketballs when leaving our school gates. Many children are bouncing their basketballs as they leave the northern gate, which you can imagine if the ball was to slip out onto the road, it could be extremely dangerous.

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

MUSICAL THURSDAY's !! – Write On Songwriting Experience

We'll be continuing with classes on Thursday afternoon at the school library from 3:45-4:45 on Thursdays.

Over the course of 2019 we will continue to embark on a musical journey touching on many of the major genres of music. In each one hour class we will compile a song based on the children's lyrical input. Throughout these sessions we will aim to introduce them to genres such as folk, rock, reggae, country, rap, pop, blues, dance, funk and tribal grooves, touching on lyrical messages, rhythm, syncopation, percussion, rhymes, hook, choral singing, chanting, backing, lead vocals and harmony.

Each class will be independent of the others, so if a child misses one class, there is no need to be concerned as to continuity. Once each session has been completed, I will take the recordings, and compile them into a listenable song for them to keep, share and distribute as they feel in MP3 format.

The classes will be priced at \$25 per session, or all 9 classes can be paid prior to term commencement for \$200. First class will be Thursday 2 May 2019. Early bird payments close Tuesday 30 April 2019.


