PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Our Public Speakers

On Wednesday evening Lily (5/6G) and Quenya (5/6T) represented our school in the Templestowe Rotary Public Speaking competition. All year 5/6 students were invited to plan, draft, edit and present a speech on one of several categories. A preferential voting system was then conducted for all students in years 5 and 6 to elect the two students who would go on to represent our school at the competition. Lily's speech was titled "If I had three wishes" and she spoke about a pet dog, ending poverty and everyone to never stop wishing. Quenya's topic was "The best invention ever" where he talked about his passion for couches. We are so proud of Lily and Quenya, as they represented our school with distinction. Quenya came third overall, but the most inspiring part about our two orally competent students was hearing about their stories about becoming confident public speakers, in particular the persistence they both showed. Lily and Quenya will share their stories and speeches at this coming Monday's assembly.



Teachers as learners

Your child may have come home this week stating they have had several teachers from other year levels visit their classroom. As part of our strategic goal, all teachers have participated in a collegiate visit model, focusing on developing teacher skills and knowledge of writing. It has been rewarding for teachers to visit other year levels and see the continuum of learning that takes place prior to or after students leave their classrooms.

On Friday and Monday teachers from Park Orchards Primary School will be visiting our school to observe the teaching and learning of our maths program. Sharing best practice is important as a system if we want all government schools to be the best they can. Our staff should feel proud of all their hard work, that now many schools visit us due to our strong academic learning growth in the Manningham region.

Print-a-car Races

Throughout this term, some year 5/6 students have been testing cars they have designed on our 3D printers with the purpose of racing them. Tomorrow (Friday) at recess, these students will be racing their cars in the gym along a pre-made race track. The team judged to have the fastest car along with a detailed portfolio documenting their team's journey will then go through to the state championships and compete against other schools. A huge thank you to Ross Toogood for providing this rich and rewarding extra-curricular activity for students at lunch time throughout term 2.

Recording Student Absences

If your child is going to be absent from school please record their absence on COMPASS.

- 1. Choose your child's photo
- 2. Go to the 'Approvals' tab
- 3. Press the Blue **Plus** symbol



- 4. Tap on 'Reason' and select option. (illness, parents' choice etc.) (Details/Comments field is optional)
- 5. Tap on **Start Date** and **End Date** (change if necessary)
- 6. Press 'Add Attendance Note'

Complete this process as soon as practical on the morning of their absence

Recording Extended Absences

If your family is going on holiday please record your child's absence using the same process as above before the date.

♦Absence Notifications

If you have not recorded an absence for your child on COMPASS, they will be marked as 'Unexplained" and an SMS will be sent to you at 10.30pm .

- If you receive an SMS, please update the absence on COMPASS or call the school office.

♦ COMPASS Notifications

All school communications are sent via COMPASS (newsletters, reminders, alters, reports etc.)

Notification are send via the app and/or email. To ensure you receive all notifications go to the settings on your phone and **Enable Notifications**.

♦ Late Arrivals

When recording late arrivals on COMPASS please choose the entire morning or afternoon session. The exact time of arrival will be adjusted when you sign your child in at the office kiosk.

♦Early Leaver

Early Leavers need to be signed out via the KIOSK at the office. Please do not record these on COMPASS.

If your family circumstances have recently changed, please notify the office so separate COMPASS accounts can be created. Personal family details will be shared unless we are otherwise notified.

Dear Parents

Thank you for choosing to register your child in the Primary School Basketball Competition for season 2 2019 to represent Templestowe Heights Primary School. This competition is run by the Bulleen Boomers and takes place after school on various days depending on your child's age and gender. The season runs for 2 terms. Children from Grades 1 to 6 can take part. Team Registrations will be taken now, late registrations may not be accepted. This registration needs to be completed for both new and current players.

Below is some information about the competition:

Season 2 commences in the first week back to school (15th July) through to November with finals in December.

Coaches and managers are needed, we can't run a team without volunteers. Please let us know if you would like to volunteer.

Team Registration – a fee of \$20* will need to be paid to cover team registration and insurance using this link https://www.trybooking.com/511974 as soon as possible so we have an idea of player numbers. YOU WILL NEED TO PAY FOR THIS ONLINE, PLEASE DO NOT BPAY TO SCHOOL.

Player Registration/Match fees - You will also need to register your child online with the Bulleen Boomers. The Boomers' season fee is usually around \$80 - \$100 which covers the matches played for the season. We will provide you with the link when we receive it before the season starts.

Training – will be at school in the gym before, during or after school, depending on the coach and gym availability.

Please register your interest as soon as possible for new players, so we can ensure there is space in a team.
