100 Days Celebrations

On Tuesday our Foundation students celebrated their first 100 days of school. The students participated in many fun activities, including a maths focus on the number...you guessed it...100. Thank you to our wonderful Foundation teachers Jacqui Nicolazzo, Ashleigh Danes and Cassandra Johnson for nurturing the youngest members of our school community; and a huge thank you to all our supportive parents and carers for making it a memorable occasion, only 2437 days of schooling to go!



Lego Robotics Team



Congratulations to our Lego Robotics Teams who represented our school in the Regional RoboCup Competition on the weekend. The two teams comprising of Alvin (5/6W), Harry (5/6T), Gregory (5/6C), Xenia (5/6W), Scarlett (5/6P), Indi (5/6P) and Renee (5/6P) had been busily coding and designing their robots to dance in a 1mx1m stage, choreographed to a song of their choice. The students received marks for their interview by a judge, portfolio presentation and were scored on their robot dance routine. This was the first time a group of students from Templestowe Heights Primary

has competed in a robotics competition, something the students should be proud of. At the end of the month the two teams will be competing in the Victorian Finals, held at the Showgrounds.

It was great to see so many parents and guardians in a different light. We even had a THPS band play on the night! All funds raised on the night will go towards our shade sails development.

Spotlight on Attendance

Did you know that the single most important in-school factor influencing student achievement is the quality of the teacher? However, the achievement of each student is greatly influenced by the amount of time students spend in the classroom (Hattie, 2009). Last year the average number of days a child at Templestowe Heights Primary was absent from school was 13.97. If a **child is absent for 15 days of school each year**, by the time they reach Year 12 they will have **missed approximately one year of school**.

Whilst we don't want students to attend school if they are unwell or prevent families from taking holidays during school term that will provide rich learning experiences, we do need to ensure we support our children to attend school daily.

Tournament of the Minds

On Monday night we had the 14 students and their parents who are representing our school in the Tournament of the Minds (TOM) attend a special information evening hosted by TOM leader and 5/6 teacher Sylvia Petrovska. The purpose of the night was to provide information about the event and for parents to gain an understanding of what is involved in the lead up and on the day of the tournament. The



parents even attempted some of the spontaneous challenges that the students will face on 8th August at La Trobe University. It was a fun session and it was entertaining to see the children score their parents on their creativity and teamwork!

Wellbeing at THPS

Today we will be running two identical information sessions focussing on wellbeing at Templestowe Heights Primary. The sessions are free and will be facilitated by guest presenter Tim Moran (Head of Education, Beyond Blue) and supported by our Wellbeing leaders Celene Black and Julia Laidlaw. The purpose of the hour-long session (2:30pm and then repeated at 6:30pm) is to explain our vision for wellbeing at Templestowe Heights Primary, explore the statistics that support our vision and the toolkit of strategies we are striving to build capacity in with all students to support their own wellbeing. Feedback from these sessions will drive the focus of further sessions. These sessions are free and open to any member of our greater community. 

Art Show Grand Opening Wednesday 4th September 2019


Hello again THPS families!

USER TIPS

• Recording Student Absences

If your child is going to be absent from school please record their absence on COMPASS.

- 1. Choose your child's photo
- 2. Go to the 'Approvals' tab
- 3. Press the Blue **Plus** symbol
- Tap on 'Reason' and select option. (illness, parents' choice etc.) (Details/Comments field is <u>optional</u>)
- 5. Tap on Start Date and End Date (change if necessary)
- 6. Press 'Add Attendance Note'

Complete this process as soon as practical on the morning of their absence

Recording Extended Absences

If your family is going on holiday please record your child's absence using the same process as above before the date. **Absence Notifications**

If you have not recorded an absence for your child on COMPASS, they will be marked as 'Unexplained" and an SMS will be sent to you at 10.30pm .

- If you receive an SMS, please update the absence on COMPASS or call the school office.

COMPASS Notifications

All school communications are sent via COMPASS (newsletters, reminders, alters, reports etc.)

Notification are send via the app and/or email. To ensure you receive all notifications go to the settings on your phone and **Enable Notifications**.

♦ Late Arrivals

When recording late arrivals on COMPASS please choose the entire morning or afternoon session. The exact time of arrival will be adjusted when you sign your child in at the office kiosk.

Early Leaver

Early Leavers need to be signed out via the **KIOSK** at the office. **Please do not record these on COMPASS**. If your family circumstances have recently changed, please notify the office so separate COMPASS accounts can be created. Personal family details will be shared unless we are otherwise notified.
