Compass Excursions – Notices and Payments

Notifications for all excursions and events will be sent to your email and via Compass. Make sure you have your notification set to 'ON' for COMPASS so that you stay up to date.

Hats On Day Monday 2nd September



Templestowe Heights Primary is a Sun Smart school. This means from the 1st September until the 30th April all students must wear their school hats, either wide brimmed or legionnaire-styled. If your child has lost or misplaced their school hat, you can purchase one from the office or visit PSW at 12 Strathalbyn Street, Kew East.

Late Pick Ups

From time to time we understand that parents and guardian are running late to pick up their children from school due to circumstance such as traffic. During these times, please ensure you call the school as a courtesy as children often get distressed when they have not been picked up.

If you are going to be later than 3.45pm please arrange for someone else to pick up your child or make arrangements for them to be placed in after school care. Staff often have meetings after school and are unable to supervise children. Pickups after 4pm are not acceptable.

GameTime by Kmart is bringing an NBL game night experience to **Templestowe Heights!**


