Compass User Tips

- Current excursions can been seen in the **Green Box** on the home screen of your Compass app or in the green box on your browser on your laptop/computer.
- To give consent and make payments, click on the green box, go to the excursion, fill in the appropriate fields and give consent. If you are then **prompted to make a payment** continue doing so as directed.
- <u>If there is NO OPTION TO MAKE A PAYMENT this means that the excursion has already been paid for</u>. (Please do not make a Bpay payment).
- To see a list of all excursions and their status click on this button on the top left hand corner of your home screen. Choose 'Events', browse the list and click on the event to see all the details pertaining to it.
