# PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

#### Arrangements for next term

Over the past week there has been a rapid change in landscape for everyone. As we enter such uncertain times, schools across the country are planning and preparing for online/remote learning. From Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> April, unless things change, we will be transitioning to online learning.

All staff have been working hard behind the scenes to ensure that come Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> April, if required, we will be ready for this new initiative.



Please know that our position on remote/online learning (and supported by the Department of Education) is that we need to be mindful of the diverse circumstances of a family's home-life. For this reason our guiding principles of what remote/online learning will look like at Templestowe Heights Primary are:

- learning activities must be self-contained and manageable and should not rely too heavily on parents as educators
- parents/carers may not be available at all times during the school day to support learning from home many will have work, caring or other responsibilities
- some students may have no or limited access to devices or the internet at home
- students with additional learning needs and students with English as an Additional Language (EAL) may need more support

The most important aspect during this self-isolation period is the need to stay connected. In the event that we transition to online/remote learning, we will be using the video conferencing platform Zoom. Information is attached to this communication that provides families with the details of registering for this free platform.

As Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> April is a designated pupil-free day, specific details about the expectations and information about how to access the online/remote learning for your child's class will be sent on this day. In the meantime, we recommend that families trial Zoom to ensure there are no glitches and are familiar with its functions.

Lastly, a reminder all families should now have their Google Classroom username and password details. Families were also sent a communication via Compass to provide consent to allow staff to communicate with students at home. Please check your Compass for these communications.

#### Everyone chipping in!

While our students commenced school holidays from Tuesday, we have had a very small number of children whose parents are essential services workers enrol each day this week. I have been so proud of the numbers of staff that have volunteered to come in and offer care and supervision. The ratios of students to staff have been upwards of 15:1!! I'll be honest though, we have been running a fairly modified program, of gardening, sport, Lego and Art. This just goes to show the commitment and genuine care our staff have of wanting to help out. I am so grateful for everyone chipping in to lend a hand.



## **Transition information for Year 6 students**

In the first week of term 2 all year 6 families will receive relevant information for secondary school enrolment via Compass. At the start of next term we will schedule a Zoom session to allow parents and carers to logon and ask any clarifying questions related to the enrolment process for students moving from year 6 to Secondary School.
