PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Welcome Back!

What a strange feeling it must be for families to start a new school term....at home. As we have transitioned to online/remote learning there have been so many committed staff that have given so much of their holidays to ensure we have been best prepared.

Please remember this is a transition phase as we start slowly with small steps, evaluating daily to see what is working well and what we can do to enhance the program. Getting our students reconnected again is the priority, getting familiar with the video-conferencing software, expectations and establishing routines are the first steps of our journey.



Our philosophy for online/remote learning is clear about equity. Every household is different, some parents are able to help more, some children require more assistance while others need to share devices and resources at home. For those children that want to do more, there are many resources we have provided on our online learning platform but we need to mindful of overwhelming many students (and parents and carers) who are "finding their feet" with this new approach or simply do not have the means or ability at present to complete any more learning tasks.

Please also remember the Department of Education's expectation with time on task for children for online/remote learning are very minimal. This is because of the complex and unique circumstances of every household.

I am also so grateful for the large number of staff that have volunteered to come in to school to supervise and care for the very small number of students that are attending on-site. I have heard that many schools are struggling to get staff to supervise on-site, this says a lot about how supportive, positive and committed our staff are to the Templestowe Heights community and particular our children.
