PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Getting into the rhythm

As we approach the end of our third week of online learning, I hope most families have now reached a point where they understand the limitations of their current home circumstances. To sum up just how extraordinary 2020 has been so far, yesterday the Pentagon (USA) confirmed video footage of UFO's and it barely made the news.



Please always remember that the most important priority right now is your families' mental health and wellbeing. When you are all juggling the demands of daily life in self-isolation it's ok if you are

having a flat day. We are all here for each other, make sure you check in with each other and please remind your child it is ok to have these feelings. There are many great resources in our wellbeing section in the THPS Online learning portal that may be of assistance.

While the initial purpose of our online learning model was to reconnect with each other, all year level teams are now focussing on gradual developments of three main aspects.

- Engagement we understand that it might be frustrating for a child to wait so long to share something during our Webex sessions. Each year level team have explored and introduced slightly different strategies to try and increase participation rates during Webex sessions.
- Scaffolding the weekly learning tasks are continuing to evolve. Year levels are placing worked examples, modelled and explanation videos as well as examples of learning tools to help bridge what is expected to be completed by the student.
- **Feedback** all teams are currently trialling ways to promote students to submit some of their learning tasks to Google classrooms where they can also receive feedback from their teacher or peers.

In the coming weeks, all year level (and specialist) teams will be provided with a half day offline, as part of mandated DET professional practice days. During this offline time, teams will be focusing on professional learning and planning that is specifically related to enhancing the online learning experience for students. Your teachers will communicate when this is taking place.

School Tours

Usually at this time of year, our students don't even bat an eyelid as groups of visitors pop into observe their classrooms as they have a tour of our school. Please let any family you know that is interested in having a virtual tour of our school that for this term we are holding school tours a little bit differently. For any family that wishes to have a school tour, they can contact the office and book a video-conference tour. During these one hour sessions parents and carers will meet with me via a video conference where they will get to learn more about our school in a virtual space.

Can you do better? A Challenge from our School Captains.

Mr Veal and myself were challenged by School Captains Sidney and Gemma to make a *Tik Tok* dance. While Mr Veal practiced for hours and hours, I did it on the first attempt. In the coming days, you will be able to view the dance on our online learning portal. While we had a lot of fun doing this, we would love to see families take up a similar challenge.

Buildings and Grounds

Last week, closed circuit TVs (CCTVs) and outdoor lighting were installed at some "hot spots" around our school. The CCTVs will now be able to monitor anyone coming in to our school via the carpark and significant monitoring of our new STEM room, library, gazebo and tiger turf. This area of our school has been dimly lit in the past and a magnet for visitors after dark.

Our shade sail that was damaged in a storm many months ago has also been replaced. Cabinetry for our new STEM room has also been installed, with only a few more pieces of furniture (that are have been ordered) that will complete this learning space, ready for use by our students.
