Welcome Back to our Junior School Students

The site of the smiles on the faces of every student as they entered school and saw their teachers and classmates was priceless. The transition back to school for our Foundation-year 2 students could not have gone any better. The big lesson this has taught me is how important connections are.

Thank you to all our parents and carers for supporting our new procedures for drop off and pick up. It has been a steady, albeit very manageable flow of students entering the school grounds in the mornings and leaving at the end of the day. Road traffic has been noticeably quieter and we can't believe how quickly the children have adapted to the new expectations.

We have been so impressed with all students showing an increased level of independence, calmly entering their classrooms, undertaking all the routines to get ready (including unpacking bags, hand hygiene, change readers) and showing how quickly they can settle into the start of a school day.

Semester 1 Reports

Due to the unprecedented times, receiving a report on your child's progress in semester 1 2020 must take into account the limitations on the ability of teachers to accurately assess student progress during the online/remote learning period. We have received advice from the Department of Education that specifies schools will not be able to implement their standard report writing process.

This coming Tuesday, classroom teachers will be busy developing a modified format for semester one reports. There will be no disruption to the normal running of the regular school programs on this day. Students in years 3-6 will continue to participate in their online/remote learning, however their teachers are not available for webex sessions. All students in Foundation-year.2 will attend as per normal school day and those students in year 3-6 that attend onsite for this day will continue to be supervised as they participate in their online/remote learning activities.

The end of semester 2 report will have a more informed and accurate assessment of your child's progress against the Victorian Curriculum.

National Reconciliation Week

This week (ending Wednesday 3rd June) is National Reconciliation Week. The theme is' **In It Together'**, allowing students to gain a deeper understanding of what reconciliation means for all of us.







Unfortunately due to the current situation where everything was temporarily put on hold as priorities changed, both our 50 years celebration and School Production have been postponed until 2021. The new date for our school Production is Monday 13th September 2021 and we are finalising the date of our 50(+1) years celebrations, but are aiming to hold it on or around the same weekend as it was booked for this year. When this date is finalised we will inform the community.

STEM Room Becomes a Fortress

We have now installed metal roller shutters to all windows of our purpose built STEM room. This added security measure is to safeguard the expensive technological hardware in the room for our students to experience. This funding would not have been possible if it were not for the strong financial leadership of Margaret and our Finance committee, but also due to the increased enrolments over recent years that have provided additional government funding.


