Enrichment News- Magic OR Maths???

As part of our Place Value & Number Maths Zone we had the chance to examine the connection between Maths and Magic. I decided to investigate the 'Choose 5 Cards' trick. I was determined to find out the math behind the magic. I wanted to know how the trick works and how I could perform the trick in multiple ways.

There was so much in my team and I wanted to begin with, but, we knew we couldn't do it all at once, so we decided to start with the basics.

First, we taught ourselves and each other how to perform the trick. The cards were laid out as shown below:

The magician then asks you to choose 5 cards, one from each pile. Once you have chosen your cards you will then be asked to add them all up and find the sum.

The magician will then ask you if you have chosen a selection of both red and black cards. You will reply with yes or no. Next, the magician will ask how many odd/even numbers you have (tell magician your answer). That part is where the maths comes in.

The first question 'Have you chosen a selection of both red and black cards?' is to make you think the colours of the cards is the only reason the trick works, however, that's not the case.

All of the odd numbers in 1-10 add up to 25 and if you add all of the even numbers together in 1-10 equals 30. Just say you asked: 'How many odd numbers do you have?' You start your number at 30 and subtract the number from 30. If you ask: "How many even numbers do you have?" you start with the number t 25 and add on however many even numbers they have.

I believe that this trick works because of the maths behind the magic. Magic tricks with cards are usually all about maths. However, when performing the trick people will try to spice it up with funny hand actions and weird words, but this maths card trick is truly the result of maths NOT magic!

Student Absences

If your child will be absent from school please record their absence on COMPASS.

- On your smart phone
 - Press the "Add Attendance Note" tab
 If you have more than 1 child at the school select the absent child
 - Tap on 'Reason' and select an option. (illness, parents' choice etc.) (Details/Comments field is <u>optional</u>)
 - 3. Tap on Start Date and End Date (change if necessary)
 - 4. Press 'Add Attendance Note'

Complete this process before 10.30am on the day of their absence

Recording Extended Absences

If your family is going on holidays please record your child's absence using the same process as above before the absence date. (Adjust the **Start Date** and **End Date** accordingly) and email your child's class teacher and the school office.

Absence Notifications

An SMS will be sent at 10.30am to all children recorded as 'Unexplained'. If you receive an SMS, please update the absence on **COMPASS** or call the school office.

COMPASS Notifications

Notification are sent via the app and email. To ensure you receive all notifications go to the settings on your phone and select "Enable Notifications".

♦ Late Arrivals Early departures

Late arrivals and early departures are recorded on the School Kiosk as your child arrives and departs the school via the office. Do not record these on Compass.

♦ School reports

Semester reports can be accessed by selecting your child's photo and pressing on the "Reports "tab

Dear Parents

We are now asking for expressions of interest for children that would like to take part in the Bulleen Miniball Competition for Term 2.

This competition takes place after school on a Friday at Bulleen Stadium in Sheahans Rd and is aimed at teaching prep aged children the rules and techniques of Basketball while playing a game.

Drop down rings are lowered for Miniball and are a good height for children of this age.

Games run for 35 minutes, start times vary each week and are between 4.10 - 6.10pm.

The umpire and coaches are on the court throughout the game to explain the rules and instructions to the players. The game consists of 2 x 15 minute halves and is not scored.

Learning the rules and how to play the game, whilst having fun, are the main goals of Miniball.

No previous experience is necessary.

The season commences the first week of term 2 (Friday 23rd April) and runs for 10 weeks.

We will need parents/relatives to help coach and manage the teams or it will not be possible. Please let us know if you can take on or help with either of these roles. Previous basketball or coaching experience is <u>not</u> necessary. You will need a current Working With Children Check which is free to apply for online <u>https://wwcv.auspost.com.au/</u>

Cost - \$80 per child for the term (we will email you the registration link from Bulleen later).

Uniform – players wear their school uniform – light blue polo and navy shorts/skort/pants and sneakers.
