PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

ANZAC Ceremony

On Friday afternoon all students and staff participated in a cultural ceremony to acknowledge ANZAC Day. Students had designed poppies, year level wreaths were laid, listened to poems, heard the ode, stood for a minute's silence as well as hear the last post. A space at the front of the stage show-cased some Australian Army memorabilia. While our school assemblies are planned and run by our school captains and year 6 leaders, this special ANZAC ceremony was organised and lead by THPS staff. The students behaved with great respect throughout as they listened to staff and guest of honour (and my father) John Coulson.



In two weeks' time all year 3 and 5 students will be participating in the National Assessment Program - Literacy & Numeracy (NAPLAN). These tests will not determine a child's future employment prospects or career possibilities. It is only a snapshot, one test per subject, of where every child's knowledge and skills attainment is comparable to their peers in all states of Australia.

We do not give our students countless tests in readiness, instead we provide some practice to ensure that when they do participate in the NAPLAN, our students are familiar with what is expected of them and are not overwhelmed by the experience. We have only ever focused on the quality of teaching and learning within classrooms.

Today all students in year 3 and 5 will receive a double-side page of information relating to NAPLAN. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to contact your child's teacher. All we ask is that our students give it their best effort, we will be proud of them no matter the outcome.

School Cross Country

On Tuesday there were the sounds of huffing and puffing as all year 3-6 students, dressed in their School House colours completed the 2km or 3km school course. Congratulations to all our students, for showing great spirit as they walked, jogged, shuffled or sprinted their way around the course. A big thank you to Kate Stacker for organising this event and for all the parents and carers who helped out, encouraging everyone at the various check-points. Well done to the top 12 finishers in each age group who now represent our school at the division championships.


School Production Planning is Under Way



Capital Works Project

Our capital works project has been progressing and we have now finalised our schematic design. The construction of a new 2-story building will house 5 classrooms downstairs and a Science, Technology and Art facility upstairs. The construction site is at the back of the school (gazebo and playground). Access by trades workers will be via Templestowe College's oval, minimising any disruption. Our administration and staffroom areas will then be refurbished following this 10-month construction.







The construction of these facilities will commence at the end of this year and the two storey building at the back of the school must be completed by the end of 2022, as required by the Victorian Government. As you can see it is a very quick process, that has involved online and in person fortnightly meetings with many parties to get this happening. I have never seen so many architects, designers, engineers, IT personal, roofing experts, soil testers and plumbers visiting our school before!

The school is extremely fortunate to have several members of the School Council who are involved in the construction industry who have attended meetings and asking questions that are keeping those involved on their toes to make sure that we get the best outcome for our school community. We will continue to keep you up to date with the progress over the coming months.

Mother's Day Breakfast and Stall



User Tips

♦Student Absences

If your child will be absent from school please record their absence on **COMPASS**.

- On your smart phone
 - 1. Press the "Add Attendance Note" tab
 - If you have more than 1 child at the school select the absent child
 - Tap on 'Reason' and select an option. (illness, parents' choice etc.)
 (Details/Comments field is optional)
 - 3. Tap on **Start Date** and **End Date** (change if necessary)
 - 4. Press 'Add Attendance Note'

Complete this process before 10.30am on the day of their absence

♦Recording Extended Absences

If your family is going on holidays please record your child's absence using the same process as above before the absence date. (Adjust the **Start Date** and **End Date** accordingly) and email your child's class teacher and the school office.

♦Absence Notifications

An SMS will be sent at 10.30am to all children recorded as 'Unexplained'. If you receive an SMS, please update the absence on **COMPASS** or call the school office.

♦COMPASS Notifications

Notification are sent via the app and email. To ensure you receive all notifications go to the settings on your phone and select "**Enable Notifications**".


♦ Late Arrivals Early departures

Late arrivals and early departures are recorded on the School Kiosk as your child arrives and departs the school via the office. Do not record these on Compass.

♦School reports

Semester reports can be accessed by selecting your child's photo and pressing on the "Reports "tab


♦Booking Teacher Conferences (Parent Teacher Interviews)
