ACTING PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Welcome to a full week back onsite! Let's hope it will be the first of many! Next week we should have a clearer picture as to what we are allowed to do at schools again. It has been frustrating but as the weeks go by and the Covid numbers stay at very low or neutral levels, we will be able to enjoy more freedoms. I will keep you informed with the new directions as soon as we receive them.

Hat On

As part of our affiliation with SunSmart, the children are now required to wear their school hats when they are outside at recess, lunch or during sporting activities. All children will be required to wear a school legionnaire or broad brim hat - this commences Monday. Children who do not bring a hat will be required to stay under cover in a shaded area. If you don't have a hat they can be purchased at PSW in Kew or we have a small selection still available at the office. Thank you for your support in protecting your children against our harsh sun rays.

School Buildings Update

Our building plans are all but organised and the tender process will commence very shortly. The pictures I have included today display the new two storey building out the back of our school and the other pictures are of our new hallways in the existing two buildings. These hallways have been redesigned to reduce heat, noise and meet current building regulations. They will now have a plastered roof but we have been able to incorporate a lot of light into this area through the installation of many skylights. Further work is scheduled to occur from September 13th with the installation of our portable buildings. This has been timetabled to mainly occur during the Term 3 school holidays.

Parking

The area along High Street is constantly monitored by the police and the parking inspectors to make sure that it remains safe for all children and the parent community. Following are a few tips that may help in the future.

Parent Tips For Legal Parking Around Schools

1. KNOWLEDGE

Be aware of **all** parking restrictions around your school.

2. COMMON SENSE

Be prepared to stop/park your vehicle **further** away from the school.

3. COMMUNICATION

When picking up your child, **agree** with your child on a location that is both legal and safe.

4. ORGANISATION

Avoid peak times by dropping off your child 5 minutes **earlier** and/or 5 minutes **later** when picking up your child.

5. UNDERSTANDING

Loading/unloading passengers in a restricted parking area is **unacceptable** and deemed illegal. The Kiss and Drop zone is a designated two minute parking zone.

6. ROLE MODEL

Set a good example for your school community and your own child by **observing** the parking restrictions.

PARENT OPINION SURVEY

WE WANT OUR PARENTS/CAREGIVERS/GUARDIANS TO TELL US WHAT THEY THINK!

Our school is conducting a survey to find out what parents/caregivers/guardians think of our school. The Parent/Caregiver/Guardian Opinion Survey is an annual survey offered by the Department of Education and Training that is conducted amongst a sample of randomly selected parents/caregivers/guardians (previously known as the Parent Opinion Survey). It is designed to assist schools in gaining an understanding of families' perceptions of school climate, student behaviour, student engagement and experiences of remote and flexible learning. Our school will use the survey results to help inform and direct future school planning and improvement strategies.

Approximately 30 per cent of parents will be invited to participate in this year's survey.

All responses to the survey are anonymous. This year, the Parent/Caregiver/Guardian Opinion Survey will be conducted from Monday 26th July to Sunday 22nd August.

The survey will be conducted online, only takes 20 minutes to complete, and can be accessed at any time that is convenient within the fieldwork period on desktop computers, laptops, tablets or smartphones. The online survey will be available in a range of languages other than English. These include: Arabic, Vietnamese, Mandarin, Chin (Hakha), Hindi, Japanese, Somali, Turkish, Punjabi and Greek.

Survey results will be communicated to parents/caregivers/guardians via the school's Annual Report to the Community. Last year, your valued feedback informed the continuing improvement of our approach to flexible and remote learning throughout 2021. Please contact the office if you would like more information.



PRIMARY SCHOOL BASKETBALL COMPETITION
2021 – SEASON 2



Dear Parents

Thank you for choosing to register your child in the Primary School Basketball Competition for season 2 2021 to represent Templestowe Heights Primary School. This competition is run by the Bulleen Boomers and takes place **after school** on various days depending on your child's age and gender. The season runs for 2 terms. Children from Grades 1 to 6 can take part.

Below is some information about the competition:

Monday nights - Grade 5/6 Boys and Girls
Tuesday nights - Grade 3/4 Boys
Wednesday nights - Grade 1/2 Girls & Boys
Thursday nights - Grade 3/4 Girls



Season 1 will commence on 19th July and run through to November with finals finishing in early December.

Uniforms – each new player will need to buy their uniform from school, which consists of shorts and a singlet (\$50*). Samples are in the school office for sizing. Please use this link if you need to buy a uniform <https://www.trybooking.com/BRYZQ>

Coaches and managers are needed, we can't run a team without volunteers. Please let us know if you would like to volunteer.

Team Registration – a fee of \$20* will need to be paid to cover team registration and administration using this link <https://www.trybooking.com/BRYZM> as soon as possible so we have an idea of player numbers. **YOU WILL NEED TO PAY FOR THIS ONLINE, PLEASE DO NOT BPAY TO SCHOOL.**

Player Registration/Match fees - You will also need to register your child online with the Bulleen Boomers. The Boomers' season fee is usually around \$110 which covers the matches played for the season. We will provide you with the link when we receive it before the season starts.

Training – will be at school in the gym before, during or after school, depending on the coach and gym availability.

Please register your interest as soon as possible for new players, so we can ensure there is space in a team.

(*a Trybooking fee of 50c will be charged in addition to these costs per transaction by Trybooking.)

Dear Parents

We are now asking for expressions of interest for children that would like to take part in the Bulleen Miniball Competition for Term 3.

This competition takes place **after school** on a Friday at Bulleen Stadium in Sheahans Rd and is aimed at teaching prep aged children the rules and techniques of Basketball while playing a game.

Drop down rings are lowered for Miniball and are a good height for children of this age.

Games run for 35 minutes, start times vary each week and are between 4.10 – 6.10pm.

The umpire and coaches are on the court throughout the game to explain the rules and instructions to the players. The game consists of 2 x 15 minute halves and is not scored.

Learning the rules and how to play the game, whilst having fun, are the main goals of Miniball.

No previous experience is necessary.

The season commences the first week of term 3 (Friday 12th July) and runs for 10 weeks.

We will need parents/relatives to help coach and manage the teams or it will not be possible.

Please let us know if you can take on or help with either of these roles. Previous basketball or coaching experience is not necessary. You will need a current Working With Children Check which is free to apply for online <https://wwwcv.auspost.com.au/>

Cost - \$80 per child for the term (we will email you the registration link from Bulleen later).

Uniform – players wear their school uniform – light blue polo and navy shorts/skort/pants and sneakers.
