Specialist Program

Next week (week 4) the 9.00am Specialist WebEx's will no longer run as staff return to Face to Face teaching. Our specialist team will be running their normal programs again onsite, something I know they are looking forward to. I would like to take this chance to thank our specialist teachers for the creative way they have stayed connected to students during Remote Learning. It has not been easy teaching PE, Performing Arts, Art and Italian to each cohort through a computer screen but their energy and positivity has ensured our students have continued to enjoy these subjects.

MASK requirements as found in the DET guidelines.

• Face masks are mandatory for children in Year 3 to Year 6, only when indoors on school premises, unless an exception applies. It is recommended for children in Foundation to Year 2.

'Exceptions include students with a medical, physical or mental disability where their disability means it would not be suitable. Parent/carers of a student/s who meet the criteria for an exception must provide their approval in writing for their child/ren to not wear a mask to the school'.

- Parents are to supply their child/children with a mask.
- Children will undertake regular hand hygiene, particularly on arrival to school, before and after eating, after blowing their nose, coughing, sneezing or using the toilet. Hand sanitiser will be made available at entry points to classrooms.

Management of An Unwell Child At School

It is important that any child who becomes unwell with COVID-19 symptoms while at school will have parents contacted and need to be picked up and Covid tested. Children cannot return until they have a negative result and are symptom free

The symptoms to watch out for are:

fever chills or sweats cough sore throat shortness of breath runny nose loss or change in sense of smell or taste Some people may also experience headache, muscle soreness, stuffy nose, nausea, vomiting and diarrhoea.

Due to the overlapping symptoms to COVID parents of children who suffer asthma and/or hay fever at this time of the year need to supply the school with the appropriate updated management plan. <u>Click here</u> for a copy of the hay fever plan.

Drop-off and pick-up:

Arrival and departure times will remain at 9.00am and 3.30pm respectively. Students *should not arrive at school prior to 8.45am*. Classrooms will not be open until 8.45am.

For the Foundation and Year 1/2 students, please deliver your child to the entry doors in the middle of the school. We ask that you then leave the grounds in a timely manner. Year 3 - 6 students should confidently be able to walk themselves to their classrooms once they have entered the school grounds. At the end of the day, while you are waiting for your child, please do not congregate in large groups and again, once you have collected your child, leave the school in a timely manner.

Visitors (including parents & carers) *are not permitted* to enter school buildings at this point. If you have business that necessitates you to visit the office, you must observe the protocols and knock on the front door and wait for the office staff to attend to you at the door.

Hats On Term 4

Please remember that all children are to wear a school legionnaires or broad brim hat when outside. Children who do not have a hat will have to stay in a shaded area.

Class requests for 2022

As part of the process of creating classes for 2022, parents or guardians with any special requests relating to their child's grade placement need to submit this in writing to me by Wednesday 3rd November. As part of our class formation process, teachers will facilitate a process where we ask all children to list five friends, where we are able to guarantee that every child will have at least one of those five friends in their class for the following year, as per policy.

Requests may relate to friendship groups, learning issues or family matters. Requests cannot be made regarding individual teachers and parents are unable to select their child's friends on their behalf.

Building Progess

Fingers crossed, tomorrow the STEM portable building will be dismantled and moved ready to be placed into its permanent position. Ground works will need to be done and then the new portable will be installed in several weeks. When complete we will be able to access our Library again.
