In the week commencing Monday 28<sup>th</sup> February we will be holding our first semester parent/carer-teacher discussions. ### **Building Update**

Demolition continues to take place in our west building in preparation for the construction of our new library, sick bay, admin office and staffroom. While there has been some noise, the builders are doing their best to leave the times when the students aren't in their classrooms. Our *Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts & Mathematics* (STEAM) building is just about ready for the foundations to be installed as the ground has now been levelled, meaning there are no more vibrations permeating through the year 5/6 classrooms.

### **FROM THE OFFICE**

### **Local Walking Permission**

From time to time students take part in local walking excursions in the neighbourhood under the supervision of our staff. **All families are invited to provide consent** for this via the Events tab in their Compass account. This permission is due by Monday 28<sup>th</sup> February.

#### **PG Movie Permission**

Occasionally students will watch PG Movies at school, while attending excursions, or on school camp under the supervision of our staff. If you are new to the school you would have received a Compass notification inviting you to complete the permission in the events tab. For existing families your previous permission will carry over for the duration that your child will be at our school. This permission is due by Monday 28<sup>th</sup> February.

### Family Contact List (Buzz List)

Every year the office compiles a class buzz list that is distributed to all members in your child's class. **If you are new to the school you would have received a Compass** notification asking you to complete the permission via the events tab to be included on this list. For existing families your details will carry over for the duration that your child will be at our school and you will automatically be included in your child's new class family contact list. If your details have changed please contact the office so we can update our system. This permission is due by Monday 28<sup>th</sup> February.

### **VOLUNTEERS AND VISITORS TO THE SCHOOL**

All parents and carers wishing to help or visit the school must hold a valid WWC.

Go to https://www.workingwithchildren.vic.gov.au to apply as a volunteer and present your card to the school office.

Visitors must also comply with vaccination requirements, density limits, face mask requirements and QR code checkins. The Education Department requires all volunteers to provide a Proof of Vaccination Certificate to the school office before volunteering in any capacity.

The second hand uniform will be open from 3.00pm to 4.00pm on Wednesday 16th and Friday 18th February.

### CAMPS, SPORTS AND EXCURSIONS FUND APPLICATIONS

The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you have a valid means-tested concession card, such as a Veterans Affairs Gold Card, Centrelink Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card, or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible. There is also a special consideration category for asylum seeker and refugee families.

Payment amounts this year are \$125 for eligible primary school students. Payments are made direct to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions and sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

If you applied for CSEF through our school last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year, unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

If you would like to apply for the first time, please contact the school office on 9850 1796 and ask for an application form.

### **PARKING**



At this busy time of the year, please be mindful of students and other drivers when parking around the school. The safety of our students is the responsibility of all of us. **The carpark is for staff only**. Please do not use the staff carpark for pickups and drops offs at any time.

### **VISITING PRIMARY SCHOOL NURSE FOUNDATION STUDENTS**

Nicole Joyce, a visiting primary school nurse from the Department of Education and Training, will be attending the school to conduct the Prep health assessments and to see other children as requested by teachers (with parents' consent).

The purpose of the visit is to provide children in their first year of primary school with the opportunity to have a health assessment; to link children, families and school communities to services available in the community; and to provide information and advice that promotes health and wellbeing.

The confidential questionnaire will provide important information about your child's health so the nurse can make an effective assessment. If your child requires further assessment, such as vision, hearing or speech assessments the nurse will see him or her at school.

- If you would like your child to participate in the Primary School Nursing Program please indicate this by ticking the YES consent box (page 5), sign and fill out the questionnaire and return the completed student entrant health questionnaire to your child's school.
- If you do not wish your child to participate in the Primary School Nurse Program please tick the NO consent box (page 5), sign and return the student entrant health questionnaire to your child's school.

Parents are invited to contact the visiting primary school nurse if there are any issues they wish to discuss. The contact number is 0459 873 959.

Once completed, can you please return the questionnaires to your child's school teacher in the sealed envelope by the specified return date.
