



In week 3 our focus topic was 'all about me'! This allowed us to get to know the students better. We ran many activities and discussions that asked them questions such as 'what do you want to be when you are older', 'what are your hobbies', 'what is your favourite colour' and 'what are you good at'. The getting to know you worksheet the students completed was then pasted in their portfolios. This prompted the students to sit back and reflect upon themselves and really think about what they love and their strengths. This created many group discussions, there was many 'me too' moments! This allowed the students to form different bonds with other students that they may not have formed connections

with yet, all because of their similarities. From this discussion we found that the students started playing career role play with other students they may not usually play with during free play time!

As a team, we created some visual aids to help the students adjust to the new routine. These visuals have prompted the students on what to do when they arrive \rightarrow wash your hands, eat your breakfast/afternoon tea, free play time, final breakfast/afternoon tea call, pack up your toys, school/home time. We went through the routines with the students as a group and discussed the routines and the order of them. This will allow each student to take initiative and clean up after themselves and to also make sure they eat before they must leave. This is a great resource for our visual learners as it resembles a visual timetable- this provides the students with consistency and understanding.

Within out getting to know you week, we found out that many students love baking! Because of that, we wanted to make baking a priority in our activity planning. This Thursday we will be baking vanilla and chocolate cupcakes with the kids, when we told them they were so excited many of them asked their parents to book them in for Thursday's afternoon session! We will always take onboard the students likes and dislikes and try our best to implement them when we can.

Dear Parents

We are now asking for expressions of interest for children that would like to take part in the Bulleen Miniball Competition for Term 2.

This competition takes place after school on a Friday at Bulleen Stadium in Sheahans Rd and is aimed at teaching prep aged children the rules and techniques of basketball while playing a game.

Drop down rings are lowered for Miniball and are a good height for children of this age.

Games run for 35 minutes, start times vary each week and are between 4.10 - 6.10pm.

The umpire and coaches are on the court throughout the game to explain the rules and instructions to the players. The game consists of 2 x 15 minute halves and is not scored.

Learning the rules and how to play the game, whilst having fun, are the main goals of Miniball.

No previous experience is necessary.

The season commences the first week of term 2 (Friday 29th April) and runs for 9 weeks.

We will need parents/relatives to help coach and manage the teams or it will not be possible. Please let us know if you can take on or help with either of these roles. Previous basketball or coaching experience is <u>not</u> necessary. You will need a current Working With Children Check which is free to apply for online <u>https://wwcv.auspost.com.au/</u> and be fully vaccinated for COVID.

Cost - \$75 per child for the term (we will email you the registration link from Bulleen later).

Uniform – players wear their school uniform – light blue polo and navy shorts/skort/pants and sneakers.
