We are thankful that we can witness the native wildlife and nature that surround THPS, including Yingabeal and Birrarung (Yarra River). We apologise for any past doing and will aim to always be Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander allies.

We would like to acknowledge how grateful we are to call this sacred country home. Always was and always will be Aboriginal land. Ngoon-godin. (Thank you)

A couple of weeks ago Rylan (1/2M) performed a traditional Yorta Yorta dance at the MCG for the AFL Indigenous round Richmond vs Essendon match. It was a special moment for Rylan as he was able to dance with his dad, other community members and embrace his cultural heritage. We are proud of you Rylan!



Building Works Update

Progress is really ticking along now in our capital works project. The temporary walls that have blocked off the area in between the admin office and the year 1/2 decking are about to come down. We are expected to have occupancy before the end of term that will see us have a new library, staffroom, sick bay and extended admin office.

This Saturday, portable toilet blocks will be installed at each end of the middle yard, as the current toilet block nearest the oval will be demolished. This is the next phase of the refurbishment that will see the construction of a new \$650,000 modern toilet block and landscaping to the middle yard. The new toilet block will have full disability access and will be reconfigured with the rest of the building so the external access is from an entrance facing the oval. During the early stages of term 3, accessibility through the middle yard will be limited as landscaping is completed (including a shelter constructed between the year 1/2 and year 3/4 entrances).
