#### **Colour Run**

On Friday the *Parents & Friends* hosted our first ever school colour run. The event brought about so much fun for our students (and staff!) as they moved around a course involving physical activities and colour-bombing stations. A massive thank you to Oula and the many, many parents and carers who organised and supported this event on the day. The staff also had fun getting colour-bombed, as did the students who were



selected to exact their revenge by squirting the colours on the staff. The event raised \$19,581 that will fund the middle yard synthetic turf landscaping over the Christmas holidays. An additional \$3200 was donated to Daniel Morcombe Foundation and Green Fleet.

#### Scriviamo! Come visit classrooms next Thursday

Scriviamo, which means to *Let's Write* in Italian, has supported students to explore and write different text types throughout the term. Our students are currently in the process of editing, revising and publishing their favourite drafted piece to celebrate themselves as authors. Next Thursday from 2:40pm, parents and carers are invited to come to school and visit classrooms to read and view the published writing pieces. Visitors will not need to sign in at the office for this event.

#### **Student Voice Sports Dress Day**

Tomorrow (Friday), our student leaders have organised a free-dress day. Students are not to bring a gold coin, instead are encouraged to bring along new children's toys, self care presents for adults, or non perishable food items that will be donated as hampers for the Doncare Christmas Appeal. Students and staff can come dressed in any sports team they support, or simply free dress.

#### **Performing Arts Incursion**

On Wednesday we had a visit from Drama Victoria. The students participated in a range of fun, engaging activities aimed at exploring their expression, movement, teamwork and spontaneity. For many of our students, these sessions show a different, expressive side and it was enjoyable to see them confidently engage.


Date: Friday 18th November
