#### PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

#### **2023 Annual General Meeting**

#### **Our Indigenous Artwork**

The artwork shows the main ideas that our year 5/6 students shared with her to help design the piece as well as fauna, flora and Birrarung (Yarra River) that is representative of the Templestowe area.


