PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Congratulations on Completing Another Term

Congratulations to all our students for an extremely busy and productive semester of school. Our Foundation students have completed their first ever semester, while our year 6 students have one more to go. Throughout these past two terms, students have participated in a variety of skills-based sessions and deep-dive tasks across all subjects as well as many opportunities to participate in activities outside their classrooms.

Walking through our classrooms I have such a strong feeling of pride and amazement at the quality of learning that our students can demonstrate. I am still blown away when our prep students can explain what a phoneme is or our year 3 and 4s know what comma splices and independent clauses are. The quality of our learning programs are driven by our wonderful teachers and supported by our equally talented education support team. I am grateful for the environment we have established at Templestowe Heights and the behaviours we are instilling in our students.

I hope families have an opportunity over the break to spend some quality time together and recharge their batteries. We will be finishing at 2:30pm tomorrow (Friday) with a whole-school assembly commencing at 1:30pm in the gym. All members of our community are able to attend. School will resume on Tuesday 11th July (Monday is a pupil-free day).

School Disco

On Friday our *Parents & Friends* held a highly successful and energy-packed School Disco. Over 300 students came in disco attire and danced (or ran) to songs played at nightclub-decibel levels. The event was extremely popular and it ran smoothly thanks to the help of so many volunteers. A special shout out to Despina who led the coordination of the event.



New Fees for Before/After School Care

School Council have been able to negotiate a new fee structure with our Out Of School Care Hours provider (OOSCH) - *Theircare*. With a new federal government rebate coming in for the new financial year, School Council were able to settle on a new fee structure that would enable the full rebate to be passed on reducing fees. Please see the table on the next page which outlines the new fees, a great outcome for our community.

Last night at our School Council meeting we had a presentation from our newly formed student canteen team. *Oscar, Logan, Inca* (5KW), *Afra* and *Anthea* (6KS) presented their business case for a student-run canteen. The proposal was extremely thorough, with everything considered in advance including what will service look like, considerations on dietary requirements, profit margins, ordering, accounting, bookkeeping and training. Thank you to our enrichment teacher Janine Reid for providing such an amazing student voice opportunity for our students. School Council have now endorsed the canteen and more information will come out at the start of next term.

What a busy week it has been! Our year 5 students visited the Queen Victoria Market as part of their unit of inquiry on the production of food and how it helps to keep us healthy. Today, students will be using their purchased products to cook in the new food technology classroom.

On Monday our Foundation students went to Myuna Farm as part of their inquiry unit *Farms and Food*. It was cold and wet but the students had a ball exploring the farm and learning about what it is like as life as a farmer. Thank goodness the students wore their gumboots!
