Over \$1200 was raised that will contribute to the recent four-square line marking that was laid over the holidays.



I would also like to acknowledge Jeanette Breen who was the lead organiser and brains behind the conference as well as Samantha Charlton and Martin Ravindran who once again presented. The focus was on the effective teaching of primary mathematics and it was a sell out again. We are now considering how we can continue to host these highly successful events in 2024, as it is exciting to know we can host and offer professional learning from our staff that benefits the education system.
