#### Writing Assessment

All students in years 2, 4 and 6 participated in a national writing assessment project with over 100 schools, led by Templestowe Heights Primary School. Students wrote (or typed) a piece based on a narrative prompt. The results will help support our whole-school writing program and identify where our students sit comparatively as well as identify gaps in student knowledge.

On Tuesday all students in years 3-6 walked down to the Aquarena Centre to participate in the House Swimming Carnival. House pride was at fever pitch as our students raced and encouraged one another. 
#### **PG Movie Permission**

Occasionally students may watch PG clips at school, while attending excursions, or on school camp under the supervision of our staff. **If you are new to the school or did not give consent in previous years you will have received a Compass** notification inviting you to complete the permission in the events tab. For existing families your previous permission will carry over for the duration that your child will be at our school. This permission is due by Friday 29<sup>th</sup> February.

## **CAMPS, SPORTS AND EXCURSIONS FUND APPLICATIONS**

The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you have a valid means-tested concession card, such as a Veterans Affairs Gold Card, Centrelink Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card, or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible. There is also a special consideration category for asylum seeker and refugee families.

Payment amounts this year are \$125 for eligible primary school students. Payments are made direct to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions and sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

If you applied for CSEF through our school last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year, unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

If you would like to apply for the first time, please contact the school office on 9850 1796 and ask for an application form.
