Influencing our System

Samantha Charlton(2SC, learning specialist) has been seconded into the Department of Education (for 4 weeks, commencing next week) as a consultant in the development and review of Victoria's suite of primary mathematics lesson plans. These lesson plans will be accessible for all primary schools across the state, covering core areas of mathematics and will be designed in line with the same guiding principles and content that we have built here at Templestowe Heights Primary.

This is recognition of Samantha's leadership and knowledge of curriculum design. It is also an acknowledgement of Templestowe Heights Primary's world-class curriculum model, which all staff have been so committed to build and deliver.

Growing our Knowledge

As part of our strategic priority of building our new maths curriculum, our teachers also need to build their professional knowledge on how to deliver it successfully. Staff participated in a professional learning session with Samantha on worded problems, where we learnt about the different types of worded problems, how to teach them effectively and the myths around how not to teach them. This aligns with our mantra of: *The quality of our programs will never be better than the quality of the teachers that deliver them.*


