#### Acknowledgement

In recent times Templestowe Heights Primary has been recognised as influencing a shift in the direction of teaching and learning in Victorian government schools. The state government has now mandated from 2025, all schools must follow our teaching and learning model, and move to an explicit teaching approach, as well as 25-minutes of phonics instruction for Foundation-Year 2.

As I have said many times before, I am extremely grateful for the courage, commitment and professionalism of all our staff for moving towards an evidence-based approach of how we teach literacy and numeracy. We follow the evidence of how we learn effectively, which in turn supports us to teach in a way that best supports all children to learn.

On Sunday night Templestowe Heights Primary featured on Channel 7 News. We showcased our reading approach and announced that next year we will be a host school for La Trobe University's Momentum School Project. You can see the news clip here:

## **SCHOOL START BONUS**

As shared with you previously, parents and carers of every child enrolled in a Victorian government school in 2025 will receive the one-off School Saving Bonus \$400 support.

In the coming months, the Department of Education will send you 2 email communications for each of your children enrolled in Victorian government schools.

By Friday 18 October 2024, please ensure that your child's 2025 enrolment is completed and that your contact information is up to date.

The 2 emails from the Department of Education will:

- 1. Confirm your email address between mid-October and late-November.
- 2. Provide you with your unique \$400 School Saving Bonus code by the end of November.

If you do not receive a confirmation email from the department by late-November, please check your spam or junk folders and contact the office if needed.

# **GET ACTIVE KIDS VOUCHER**



Eligible Victorian families can now apply online for a \$200 Get Active Kids voucher. These vouchers can be redeemed at registered providers, such as local sporting clubs or organisations. The program is open to Victorian children aged 18 and under, named on a valid Commonwealth Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card and named on a valid Medicare Card at the time

of application. A special consideration stream is also available to support children in care, temporary or provisional visa holders, undocumented migrants and international students up to 18 years at the time of application.
