PSW (Primary School Wear Information)

PSW is currently open Monday to Saturday to assist families with the end of year rush. Families are able to book a 20-minute appointment via the PSW website from now until early January with a dedicated team member to assist you and your child. It makes the whole shopping experience that much better and less overwhelming for new students.

Please note from mid-January PSW do not take appointments, and they often have very long queues. This can be overwhelming for some students. If parents are worried their children will grow, please know that the PWS team will fit for growth. If all clothing items have their tags on them, are not worn, washed or labelled they can be exchanged for a different size prior to the child commencing at school.



Child Care Subsidy

Please note that subsidised hours are calculated and allocated by Centrelink on a fortnightly basis. Check Centrelink for eligibiligy. Each session is calculated using the full service operational hours, not the hours attended by the child.

Unexpected changes to activities

In the unlikely event that an activity is unable to run, an alternative activity will be provided.

Activities and times are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances such as severe weather or provider availability. If an alternative cannot be sourced we will update your invoice to reflect this.

Medical Management Plan ६ Medication

All children who have been diagnosed with a medical condition including allergies, food/chemical intolerances, anaphylaxis, asthma, epilepsy will need to provide:

- a completed Medical Management Plan with a colour photo
- necessary medication

Please note it is a legal requirement under the Education & Care National Regulations and the Terms and Conditions for booking that these are provided.

In the interests of child safety, care may be refused on the day should the appropriate documentation or medication or medication not be supplied.

Changes to your booking

Simply log into your account anytime to make the relevant changes or call us between 8:30am – 9:00pm weekdays on 1300 072 410.



Fees for changes to your booking

More than 5 days	Less than 5 days *	On the day
No Charge	\$10.00	Full Fee

*Less than 5 days from the start of the booking (120 hours from the start of the session).

When making additional bookings, the \$10.00 fee is eligible for the Child Care Subsidy, which means you may only need to pay the gap, depending on your families' circumstances.
