Staff Learning...Parents and Carers Learning

As part of our strategic goals around building teacher knowledge and expertise, all teaching staff participate in weekly professional learning sessions. These sessions are facilitated by our learning specialists and on Wednesday the focus was on enhancing our core knowledge curriculum. Our core knowledge curriculum incorporates the subjects of, history, geography, science, economics, civics & citizenship and design technology. It is the key knowledge we aim to teach students to allow them to have a deeper understanding of the texts they read.

Keeping the classroom learning theme going, we also had our Year 1-6 Parent/Carer information session. It was a big turnout, where attendees participated in writing and maths lessons that allowed them to better understand how our explicit teaching model looks for their children. There were lots of rich discussions and so much enthusiasm amongst the group.


