PRINCIPAL'S REPORT


Welcome Pre-Service Teachers

THE LEARNING LENS SERIES

Issue 5: How We Teach Reading – Systematic Synthetic Phonics

Learning to read isn't something children just "pick up". It is a complex skill that must be taught with precision and structure.

At THPS, we use an approach called Systematic Synthetic Phonics (SSP) to teach early reading. This method is backed by decades of international research and is proven to be the most effective way to teach all children to read, especially those who may struggle.



Here's what that looks like in our classrooms:

- We teach letter-sound relationships in a clear, planned sequence
- Students learn to blend these sounds to decode unfamiliar words
- Skills are practised every day through short, focused, and engaging lessons

It's not about guessing from pictures or first letters. It's about equipping every student with the tools to crack the alphabetic code.

SSP helps students build fluency from the ground up. That fluency is what frees them to understand what they are reading.

This structured approach doesn't just support early success, it prevents reading failure. And that's what all students deserve.

Next week, we'll share how we *build knowledge and vocabulary alongside decoding* because phonics is the starting point, but never the end goal.




We are looking forward to celebrating these special events with our students.


