#### Early leavers

For those students leaving early, parents/carers must come to the office and sign them out on the COMPASS kiosk and collect a blue early leavers pass. This pass needs to be presented to the teacher upon pick up. Please do not place the absence of COMPASS.

To give families even more opportunities to join in the fun, the library opened with extended hours this week – it's been wonderful to see so many children keen to explore new stories.






