## Templestowe Heights Primary School Acceptable Use Agreement for Internet and Digital Technologies

Templestowe Heights Primary School believes the teaching of cybersafe and responsible online behaviour is essential in the lives of students and is best taught in partnership between home and school.

21<sup>st</sup> century students spend increasing amounts of time online, learning and collaborating. To be safe online and to gain the greatest benefit from the opportunities provided through an online environment, students need to do the right thing by themselves and others online, particularly when no one is watching.

Safe and responsible behaviour is explicitly taught at our school and parents/carers are requested to reinforce this behaviour at home.

Some online activities are illegal and as such will be reported to police.

## School support for the safe and responsible use of digital technologies

Templestowe Heights Primary School uses the internet and digital technologies as teaching and learning tools. We see the internet and digital technologies as valuable resources, but acknowledge they must be used responsibly.

Your child has been asked to agree to use the internet and mobile technologies responsibly at school. Parents/Guardians should be aware that the nature of the internet is such that full protection from inappropriate content can never be guaranteed.

At Templestowe Heights Primary School we:

- have policies in place that outline the values of the school and expected behaviours when students use digital technology and the internet
- · provide a filtered internet service
- provide access to the Department of Education and Training search engine Connect (<u>www.education.vic.gov.au/primary</u> which can be used to direct students to websites that have been teacher recommended and reviewed
- provide supervision and direction in online activities and when using digital technologies for learning
- · support students in developing digital literacy skills
- have a cybersafety program at the school which is reinforced across the school
- use mobile technologies for educational purposes (e.g. podcasts or photos from excursions)
- provide support to parents/guardians to understand this agreement (e.g. language support)
- provide support to parents/guardians through information evenings and through the document attached to this agreement for parent to keep at home

I have read the Acceptable Use Agreement carefully with my child and understand the significance of the conditions and agree to abide by these conditions. I understand that any breach of these conditions will result in internet and mobile technology access privileges being suspended or revoked.
